- To implement Accelerated Reader (AR).
- To focus on improving students' Math scores through professional training on Math Domains and Strategies in order to increase mathematical and

- numeracy fluency and concept formation.
- To implement a SLE self assessment project in Kindergarten (beginning); Fourth grade (middle); and 8th grade (end)
- For continual professional Technology training to equip our educators and instructional paraprofessionals to create a better student-centered, inquiry based learning environments.
- To provide support and increased services for students in the fourth quartile
- For administration to continue its efforts to expand its physical plant to increase services for its diverse population
- To keep abreast of modern methods of technologies in order to enhance student learning and Faith Formation.

As per accreditation protocol, the school selected 3 goals among the 12 identified to address within a 3 year span.

The school created a 3-year Action Plan to address the following 3 critical goals:

- 1. To create a school advisory board.
- 2. To update the current Holt/Open court program and integrate Accelerated Reader into the curriculum.
- 3. To provide opportunities for students to develop their critical thinking skills in the area of Science.
